"My Life" Video Slideshow – 100 pts.

Students will create a photo movie about themselves, "My Life." The content of each individual movie should reflect on a student's life beyond school. They will import their images into "Photos" and edit their movie using iMovie. They will be given the opportunity to borrow a camera from the class or they are welcome to use their own cameras.

Step #1: Submit a Storyboard (20 pts)

A storyboard must be submitted prior to taking the photos. A storyboard is a visual representation of what is to be filmed. (Students do not have to use all the frames provided on the Storyboard).

Step #2: Take "My Life" Photos: Home, Family, School, Friends & Hobbies. (10pts)

- At a minimum, each student took and used at least 5 photos for each of the following segments: 1. Home, 2. Family (pets), 3. School, 4. Friends, 5. Hobbies. You may include additional segments, of your choosing.
- Import your images to "Photos;" if you forget, replay the "Photos" video tutorial.
- Once imported, create an "Album." Title it: "MyLife YourName."

Step #3: Create Your Movie Using iMovie.

Grade Sheet - (70 pts.)

- 1. Open iMovie.
- 2. Create a **New Project**. Title it: "MyLife_YourName." (5pts)
- 3. Importing Photos
 - a. Connect to "Photos" & drag images onto Timeline. (10pts)

Helpful Hints:

- b. Can't find the Album of images you created in Photos? Solution here.
- c. Reduce the size of the thumbnails on the timeline.
- d. Adding multiple photos to timeline!
- e. Rearranging the photos on the timeline.
- f. Deleting a photo from the timeline.

Note: Hints on Viewing Your Movie.

4. Titles

- a. Adding a title with a black background. (5pts)
 - Titles should be inserted at the beginning and end of movie and before each segment.
 - Add a "Thank You" title at the end of the movie.
- b. Adding Subtitles. (5pts)
 - Add at least 5 subtitles.

5. Transitions (10pts)

a. Transitions should be added before and after each Title and Photo. Add a "Thank You" title at the end. Time Saving Tip: Adding multiple transitions at once.

6. **Timing** (5pts)

- a. The video shall be no shorter than 1 minute & no longer than 4 minutes.
- b. Each slide should be 3 to 4 seconds in length.

7. Special Effect (5pts)

a. Add a "Ken Burns" effect to at least 5 images.

8. Music (5pts)

a. There should be background music composed by the student using Garage Band, heard throughout the video. Any cropping of the audio track must not be recognizable to the viewer – so fade these music tracks!.

9. Export Video to Desktop & RLS Multimedia Server. (5pts)

- a. Export Video to Desktop.
- b. Then drag it onto the RLSMultimediaServer.

Quality Standards. The student attempted to create an interesting and professional quality film:

- 1. The subject in all the photos is not hidden in darkness. (5pts)
- 2. The camera was held steady No Blurred images!. (5pts)
- 3. All scenes are framed well and backgrounds were taken into consideration. (5pts)
