<b>Step#1: Acquire Photos</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Go to Google Images and find 5-6 images that you would like to appear behind you in place of the Green Screen. (5pts.)</li> </ul>	5 pts.
<b>Step#2: Create A New Project - Import Your Green Screen Film Into Final Cut Pro</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Create a new Project in the previously made Event. (5pts.)</li> <li>Import the video, photos and music track into this event. (5pts.)</li> </ul>	10 pts.
<b>Step#3: Drag the Video &amp; Photos Onto The Timeline:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Drag the video and photos onto the timeline and (5pts.)</li> <li>Add titles and transitions. (5pts.)</li> </ul>	10 pts.
<b>Step#4: Remove The Green Screen Background &amp; Add Background Images and Music</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Line up the green film with the background images and "Chroma Key" the background. (5pts.)</li> <li>Add music and adjust the volume when someone is speaking. (5pts.)</li> </ul>	10 pts.
